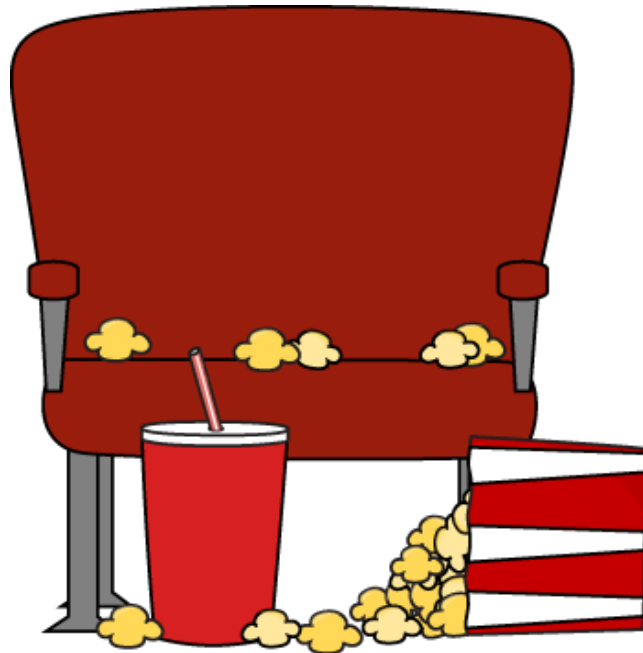


Welcome to Tuesday Morning Matinees for Adults!

Shiz University in the fantastical Land of Oz and forge an unlikely but profound friendship.
